CARFLEO Conference 2019

"Land and Water: Sacred Gifts of the Creator" March 28-29th, 2019

Our 2019 CARFLEO Conference and AGM will be held at the Queen of Apostles Renewal Centre in Mississauga. Our AGM will be held on the afternoon of March 28 with the Conference beginning that evening. We will continue on March 29. Every Catholic teacher in attendance can be present at the AGM (we are all members of CARFLEO.)

The theme of the 2019 CARFLEO Conference flows out of Pope Francis'

encyclical Laudato Si'. Having learned about the giftedness and culture of the Indigenous people in our last two conferences, we want to bridge that knowledge with Pope Francis' call to care for our common home, Mother Earth. Our keynote speaker is **Sister Mary Rowell**, a member of the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Canada. Mary is a member of the Team at Villa St. Joseph Ecology and Retreat Centre in Cobourg, Ontario. She is also a part-time faculty member at the University of Toronto, where Mary teaches Moral Theology and Catholic Social



Teaching at St. Michael's and Regis Colleges. Mary also provides workshops and retreat facilitation with various Catholic School Boards which she always finds enjoyable and inspirational.

There will be two workshops offered before the conference begins. One will showcase the new Grade 6 Growing in Faith, Growing in Christ religious education program by Pearson's Stephanie Wells. A second workshop will be a *Visio Divina* experience led by Les Miller. It will be a gentle way to enter into the experience of the conference as well as a practical exploration of a powerful teaching strategy.

Priorities for CARFLEO's web presence for 2019 are:


- Complete school board resources, Sacraments and Liturgical Year series
